SEVERAL RENOVATIONS COMPLETE & MORE TO COME!

The Tyler County Speedway, under the direction of Hometown Racing Association (2013-current), with help from the Tyler County Fairboard and several tremendous sponsors, has undergone a major face lift in the last decade. Projects like new electric and track lighting, a state-of-the art new press tower, a much larger working pit tower, new concession buildings, a new pavilion for fans to find some shade, new guardrail and track lights for safety, new track resurfacing twice, new infield drainage, flat kart/mini wedge track in infield, new flagstand and of course the huge undertaking that was the new aluminum bleachers have the facility looking better than ever.

We have come to a pivotal time in auto racing as the younger generation demands a more fan friendly interactive experience while our older fans require a more fan friendly and most importantly safer structure to enjoy their Saturday Night entertainment. Therefore, continuous upgrades and improvements to modernize our infrastructure and continue efforts to make Tyler County Speedway one of the nations premier short tracks of the future vital as it moves towards five decades of existence.

Phase 4:	Pitside Bleachers in Turn 3 & Turn 4, Fan Friendly Picnic Shelter (complete)
Phase 5:	Infield Drainage, New three rows high Guardrail, Track Re-Surfacing (complete)
Phase 6:	Installed New Bleachers (Frontstretch and Backstretch) (complete)
Phase 7:	Built infield Flat Kart/ Mini Wedge track, erected awesome 'Bull' statue (complete)
Phase 8:	Installation of new PA System (complete)




